

URBAN PARK AND RECREATION FUND

Appropriation Language

For expenses necessary to carry out the Urban Park and Recreation Recovery Act of 1978 (16 U.S.C. 2501-2514), \$4,000,000, to be derived from the Land and Water Conservation Fund, to remain available until expended.

Justification of Proposed Language Changes

Addition: "For expenses necessary to carry out the Urban Park and Recreation Recovery Act of 1978 (16 U.S.C. 2501-2514), \$4,000,000, to be derived from the Land and Water Conservation Fund, to remain available until expended."

This language is the same as that used to appropriate Urban Park and Recreation Recovery grant funds previously, except that additional language is included to fund this appropriation from the Land and Water Conservation Fund, as part of the President's Lands Legacy Initiative.

Appropriation Language Citations

1. For expenses necessary to carry out the Urban Park and Recreation Recovery Act of 1978 (16 U.S.C. 2501-2514), \$ \_\_\_\_\_.

16 U.S.C. 2501-2514

16 U.S.C. 2501-2514 authorizes the establishment of an urban park and recreation recovery grant program, defines how it shall be administered, and provides appropriation authorizations in limited amounts which remain available until appropriated.

2. to be derived from the Land and Water Conservation Fund,

16 U.S.C. 460 1-5 and 6

16 U.S.C. 460 1-5 and 6 establishes the Land and Water Conservation Fund, provides for \$900,000,000 annual revenues to the fund through fiscal year 2015, and authorizes appropriations from the fund.

3. to remain available until expended.

16 U.S.C. 2512

16 U.S.C. 2512 authorizes appropriations "to remain available until expended."
